COVID-19 information for course members

While the successful vaccination programme has reduced the threat from Covid 19 and led to much easing of restrictions on our way of life, it does still have the potential to cause illness and to interfere with plans. It is important to us that we minimise the chances of disruption to your own holiday or that of other course members. We have therefore kept dedicated workstations and extra spacing in our studios and can react to any sudden virus changes without cancelling holidays through extra screening in the house, and the provision of a supply of disposable facemasks and hand sanitiser.

We have found over the past two years that guests had no problem socialising and getting to know each other with or without glass screens in the house, as well as when relaxing in coffee breaks in the garden, on walks around the area and of course on our outside visit days.

To help us avoid the disappointment of cancelled courses, we do ask you to ensure you have had an up-to-date booster vaccination and recommend that you take a lateral flow test shortly before arrival. If by chance you test positive just before the holiday, we are happy to move your booking to a future date. In the unlikely event that conditions cause cancellation of a holiday despite our precautions, we will refund your course fees in full.
